



## Dufferin Arts Council | Community Grants Program

- Description** The Community Grants Program supports artists and arts organizations undertaking creative activities that will enhance the arts in Dufferin County.
- Frequency** Quarterly
- Value** The Dufferin Arts Council (DAC) may award up to a maximum of \$500 per quarter, based on a review of proposals received. The value and number of grants per year depends on the number of applicants and the funding available. These grants are made solely at the discretion of the Community Grants Committee. (Larger grants will be reviewed by the DAC Board of Directors based on recommendations from the committee.)
- Eligibility** **Must be** a member of the Dufferin Arts Council, either as an artist working alone or a community group in which a member of DAC is involved, proposing a unique arts project or event to take place in Dufferin County. Artists or organizations that have received a grant must wait two (2) years before re-applying.
- Timeline** Applications for these grants must be received no later than the 14<sup>th</sup> of March, June, September or December. The committee reviews all applications received during each quarter. Decisions are made and applicants contacted by the end of the quarter in which they are received. Please note that, if necessary, a request may be deferred to the following quarter.
- To Apply** All applications will be carefully and respectfully considered. Eligible applications will include a description of the person or organization submitting the request as well as a detailed description of the project and location.
- Please use the attached form to provide details of your proposal. This must include:
- A contact name, email address, mailing address and telephone number
  - A brief resume of the person or group
- Please remember:
- Complete the application form in full and submit it in hard copy with any supporting material (including photos) you feel necessary to present your idea/proposal
  - Artist must be a member of DAC, organization must include a member of DAC
  - DAC reserves the right to reject applications that are incomplete
  - DAC would welcome a note on completion of the project and any pictures, when appropriate, for inclusion in a subsequent issue of our ArtsLetter.
