

Dufferin Arts Council | Ann Laurier Scholarship Program



- Overview** The Dufferin Arts Council’s scholarship program recognizes exceptional students of Dufferin County who will be pursuing post-secondary education in the visual, performing or literary arts. The program consists of three (3) one-time scholarships worth \$2500.00 each. One scholarship will be awarded to each of the arts streams—visual, performing (including music) or literary.
- Eligibility** The applicant **must be** a resident of Dufferin County, be graduating in the current year, be accepted to a recognized post-secondary institution.
- To Apply** Completed applications must be received by the deadline of 30th June and must include the following information.
- Completed application form including an essay of no more than 500 words.
 - Transcripts from grades 12
 - Letter of reference preferably from a current teacher in the relevant discipline
 - Proof of admission to post-secondary institution of the project
 - Portfolio or CD, DVD or USB appropriate to the discipline

Completed applications will be reviewed by the selection committee. Successful applicants will be notified by the final Friday in August. In early September cheques will be deposited to the students’ accounts at the post-secondary institutions in which they are enrolled.
